

SCCC – WAIT IN FAITH

S - Scriptures

“Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord.” Psalm 27: 14

C – Consideration

In Psalm twenty-seven, David disclosed a spiritual battle in his own soul. He declared his confidence in God as his stronghold, his light, his salvation and in a soul-searching, he whispered: “Whom shall I fear?” Expressing about evil people coming after him to attack and devour his flesh, he positively said, “they will stumble and fall, my heart will not fear.” He kept affirming in faith, “Though my father and mother forsake me, the Lord will receive me.” However, his prayer kept waving from faith to doubt: “Do not hide your face from me, do not turn your servant away in anger; you have been my helper. Do not reject me or forsake me, God my Savior. Do not turn me over to the desire of my foes. “Yet, in the midst of his confusion, he didn’t allow his fears, overcome his faith, but made sure to declare in faith loudly and clear before finishing his prayer, “I remain confident of this: I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.” And, in conclusion, he spoke prophetically “wait for the Lord.”

C – Commitment

How many times we face the same types of warfare in our minds. We speak words of faith, and we look like strong believers, but, when we go to the Lord in prayers, our words seem full of doubts, denying what we declared hours before. Most of the time, the enemy is the one responsible for these types of behavior. David was not just speaking of deliverance from people, but also against a supernatural attack. That is the way the devil acts, he knows the power of our words when we speak in faith, therefore, he brings fears, guilt and other negative and sinful thoughts, to destroy our confidence. That is the reason David didn’t allow these demonic feelings to steal his blessings, speaking loudly the promises of God, not just for eternity, but in the land of the living as well, prophetically speaking to God’s people, to be calm, be strong, be encouraged for He will act in His time.

C – Call

Heavenly Father, Your word teaches me every day. How often have I spoken in faith, but kept doubt in my heart, listening to the enemies’ voices. Thank You, my God, that I learned that my closing prayer should be done in faith. You are my shield, my strength, my provider in the land of the living, therefore, I will fear no evil.
