S - Scriptures

“Who among the gods is like you, Lord? Who is like you— majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders?” Exodus 15: 11

C – Consideration

The Israelites were running from the enraged Egyptian Army. They had experienced the plagues the Lord had sent to their nation, and they wanted to bring Israel back to slavery again. “When the king of Egypt was told that the people had fled, Pharaoh and his officials changed their minds about them and said, “What have we done? We have let the Israelites go and have lost their services!”(14:5) In the midst of Israel’s desperation, God opened the sea for His people to pass through it, and when their enemies enter after them, “the water flowed back and covered the chariots and horsemen—the entire army of Pharaoh that had followed the Israelites into the sea. Not one of them survived” After crossing to the other side, the Israeli community sang a song to the Lord. In their despair, they came to know who the Lord was, as they answered their own question: He is Holy, Glorious, and Magnificent.

C – Commitment

As a Christian, I can apply this entire song to my life. Like Israel, “I will sing to the Lord, for he is highly exalted. “The Lord is my strength and my defense; he has become my salvation. He is my God, and I will praise him, my father’s God, and I will exalt him.
